




PROGRAMS CONDUCTED DURING FY 2024 - 2025














2. Digital Content Generation

This membership is valid for a tenure of 10 years.

31. Associates

Academics/Researchers/Teachers/Practitioners in any branch of Science, Technology, Engineering, Agriculture and Medicine, working or retired from Educational/Research and related organisations including Corporate, are being admitted as associates. Individuals who are desirous of becoming Associates of KSTA may do so by paying a fee of Rs. 1,000/- (Rupees One thousand only), and submitting a duly filled application form available on the KSTA website throughout the year. During FY 2023-24, 24 applicants were admitted as associates out of the total 151 applicants admitted as associates of KSTA so far.
